How many wristbands can I order?

Maximum of 6 per household

When will I receive the wristbands?

Everyone with an email address will receive immediate confirmation of their order and all wristbands will be sent by post after the deadline of Wednesday 24 October. (please allow a few days for delivery)

What happens if all wristbands get allocated?

Don't worry there will still be plenty of places to view the fireworks outside the 2 main viewing areas – (see viewing area information inside) and the general rule is if you can 'See the castle – you can see the fireworks!'
