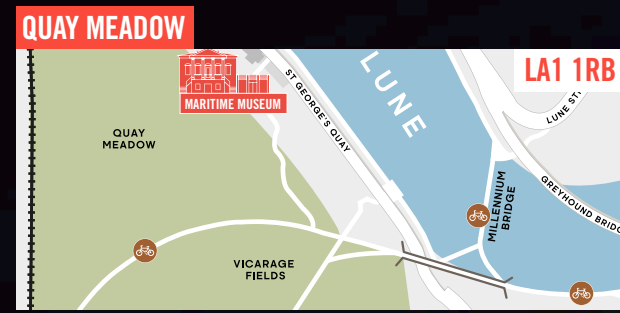
SATURDAY 02 NOVEMBER - 8PM

GIANT AXE

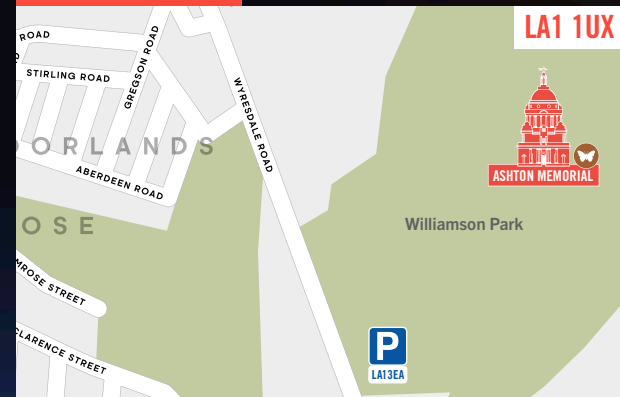

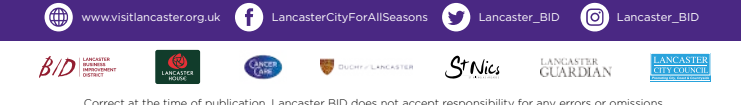

LANCASTER CASTLE COURTYARD

LIGHTSCAPE by MammasONica (Italy)

Lightscape is an immersive multi-layered experience, creating a luminous landscape evolving through time. With flowing colours and tone, MammasONica create a forest in a courtyard and the skies upon the earth. With a choral piece to celebrate the flow of time, the digital canvas renews itself, taking us on a narrative journey from dusk till dawn.



PRIORY CHURCH

MUSEUM OF THE MOON by Luke Jerram

Measuring seven metres in diameter, the moon features 120dpi detailed NASA imagery of the lunar surface. At an approximate scale of 1:500,000, each centimetre of the internally lit spherical sculpture represents 5km of the moon's surface. CASTLE PARK

LIFT OFF by BCL Lighting-Design (Brent Lees)

Lift Off is Lancaster's entry into the space race! It's July 1969. The stage is set, the launch pad is ready, engines are primed, the space craft points to the sky, the astronauts are strapped into their seats & mission control is counting down... Take your place at the viewing area to witness the launch!

PRIORY STEPS

BIRDS OF A FEATHER by Sandy Gardner

Step into an illuminated, picturesque skyscape and become part man, part bird. It's a chance for a smile and a selfie style picture that you can share. Bring your camera, strike a pose and use your imagination to soar into the night sky and unite as a flock of illuminated birds. A photographer will be there and images will be available online for free download.

PIZZA MARGHERITA

FROM THE CANAL by green.box.arts

Some water birds have left the canal and waddled down Moor Lane to find themselves illuminated by Light Up Lancaster - now they are ready to soar.

VIDEO ART TRAIL by Graff

Showcase of contemporary digital works by diverse emerging artists in unexpected locations around the Lancaster city centre.



LANCASTER QUAYSIDE AND MARITIME MUSEUM

CLOSE TO THE WIND by Dan Fox

Close To The Wind is a huge vibrating projection screen controlled by the wind. Made from hundreds of strips of white elastic stretched between two ex-military communications masts, the elastics vibrate as the wind blows creating sounds and visual patterns. Projected images synchronised to the wind by anemometers interact with the elastics.



JUDGES LODGINGS

A SPACE INVASION by Ash Murphy and Aaron Kara

A Space Invasion is an interactive experience taking you back to the nostalgic time of the 1980s. Revisit the classic game of space invaders and put yourself in the hot seat. Meet the space police, take control of the ship and fight the aliens on an 80 ft building! Be the conductor to a synth band soundtracking your gaming experience live whilst you join us in the skies and see the game revisited like never before in all its 8bit glory.



MARKET SQUARE

THE PROMENADE OF GALAXIES by Ludus Dance with Illuminos

The Promenade of Galaxies celebrates the 50th anniversary of the moon landing, questioning the meaning of the most optimistic event of the 20th Century. Devised and performed by their flagship youth company, Ludus Dance presents a participatory multi-cultural perspective on the race to the moon.



NEW STREET

DISTANT VOICES by Mark Parry

A series of wormholes (theoretical short cuts in space/time through which we can reach far off places in the universe). Within each portal we hear voices from other times and places.

SPACEMAN by Blackpool Illuminations

First designed by Alan Cockcroft in 1970 to celebrate the moon landings, this iconic 3 metre high structure is a replica of Neil Armstrong's space suit and is a fun, vintage illumination.

PHAROS by Joe Moran

A dynamic sculpture designed to absorb light, which is then projected outwards in organic patterns rotating like a lighthouse. Named after one the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World.

THE HAPPINESS SUM by Gemma Wood

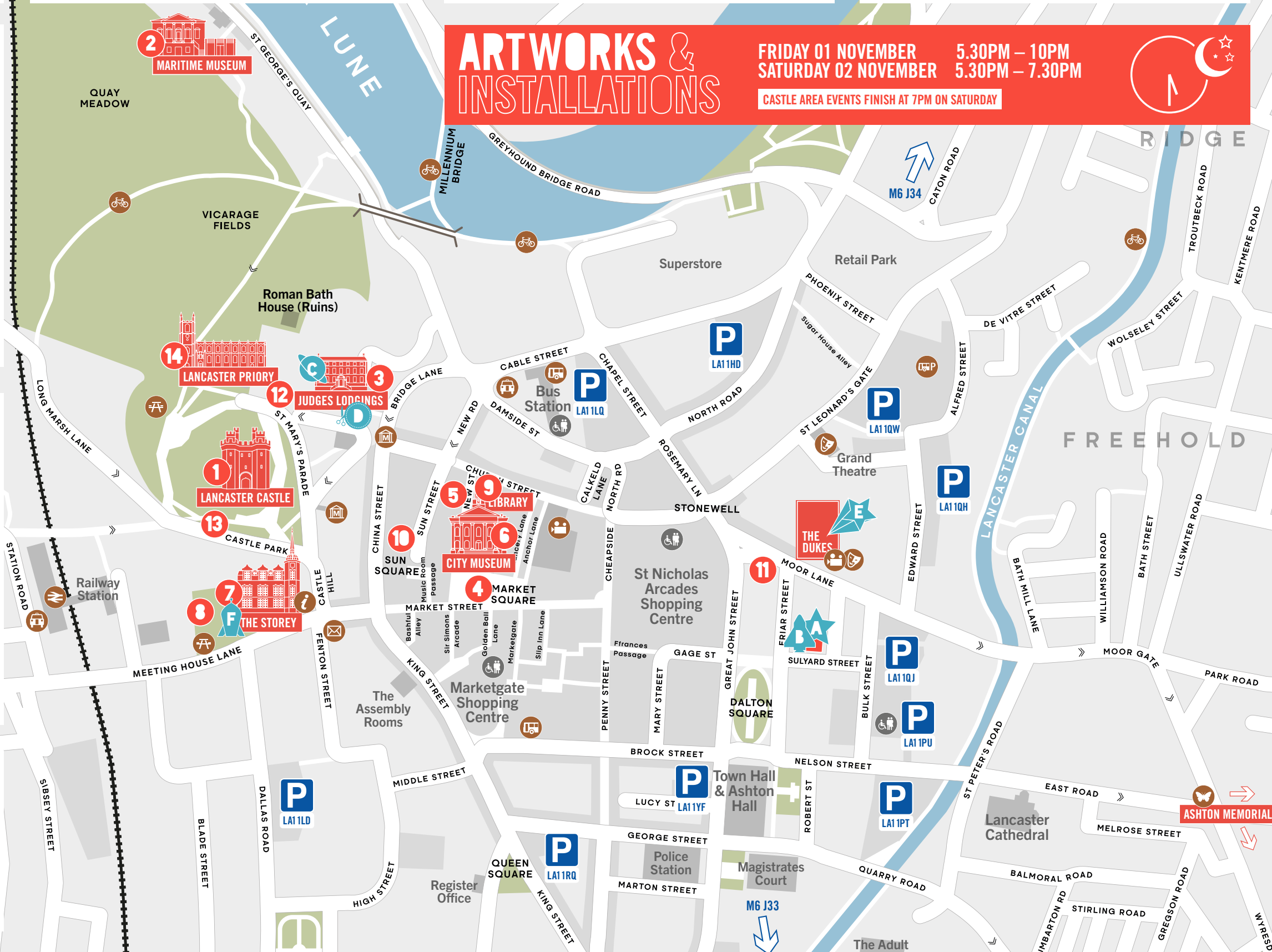
The Happiness Sum is a playful, interactive installation that poses important questions about what activities make us happy... and by how much! Beautiful and intriguing, it encourages us to check if, in our fast-paced society, we are maximising our happiness potential.

HEADSPACE by City Museum

The City Museum offers the perfect chill-out zone with its soft-focus light of 'inner space' guiding you peacefully to a different experience at the festival. Created specially to complement its current exhibition by artist, Andy Farr, the zone is a reflective, sheltered location where the inner journey of human life can be understood as the final frontier.

MAGIC ISLANDS IN SPACE by More Music, BREAD Art and Lancaster Arts

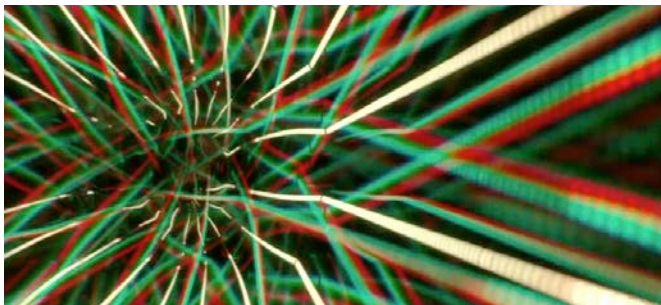

DIY FILM by GRAFT (Ellie Barrett and Saul Argent)

STOREY READING ROOM

PORTAL OF REFLECTON by Tom Lambert

A kaleidoscopic experience of wonder through animated light and sound. Gaze through special glasses into a portal to a world of colour and allow yourself to be transported to a place of self reflection, taking a moment to feel nourished and to appreciate the wonder of life, the universe and everything.



STOREY COURTYARD

INVISIBLE TRANSPARENT by Sumit Sarkar

A multi-process sculpture, fusing two kinds of marble made at the Digital Stone Project in Italy with complex multi-material 3D printed parts, Invisible Transparent incorporates a lighting system and interactive AR bringing the sculpture to life with 3D animation, viewable and interactive on your smart phones.



STOREY MUSIC ROOM

HEAVENS ABOVE by Jonny Randall and The Dukes

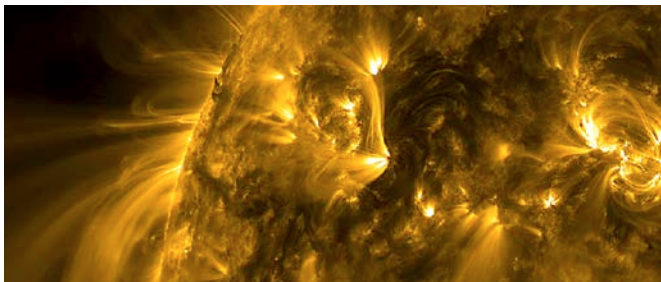

SUN is a partnership between public artist Alex Rinsler and leading solar physicist Prof. Robert Walsh; co-commissioned by Light Up Lancaster, Lightpool Festival and support from Arts Council England and the Science and Technology Facilities Council.
